



Carbon Monoxide (CO) is a highly toxic gas that is very dangerous because it is colorless, odorless, tasteless, and non-irritating. That's why a smoke detector is fundamental for you safety.



**1 INSTALL**

Landlords are required to provide and install at least one approved carbon monoxide detector within each dwelling unit and provide written information about how to test and maintain them. The carbon monoxide detector must be installed within 15 feet of the primary entrance to each sleeping room.

Landlords must install smoke detectors in each apartment but tenants are responsible for maintaining them. If a tenant has removed the smoke detector or failed to replace its battery, he/she must return it to proper working order.

- Tenants have to:
- Test all carbon monoxide and smoke detectors at least once a month
  - Replace the batteries in carbon monoxide and smoke detectors at least twice a year
  - You will hear an alarm sound when the battery is low. Replace the battery immediately
  - Use only the type of batteries recommended on the detector
  - Never paint over carbon monoxide detectors
  - Replace carbon monoxide detectors as recommended by the manufacturer
